North Bay Credit Union opens new branch, relocates another

SANTA ROSA— “We’ve served the community for over 70 years, but our most dynamic expansion has taken place in the last few years,” said North Bay Credit Union CEO Chris Call. “Since 2015, we’ve grown exponentially and added three new branches while upgrading and relocating our main office.”

“Of course, we offer our members a complete package of mobile banking services for easy access to their accounts. But, we also recognize that many like having a branch near them where they can talk about home and auto loans and open accounts for their family members.”
